IBC 2009 Significant Changes

Familiarizes building officials, fire officials, plans examiner, inspectors and design professionals with many of the important changes in the 2009 IBC. Assists code users in identifying the specific code changes that have occurred, and more importantly, understanding the reason behind the change. Focuses on those code changes selected due to their frequency of application, special significance or change in application. Discusses over 120 changes, with a major emphasis on those provisions addressing fire and life safety. Presents a number of significant changes to the structural and material provisions of Chapters 16 through 23 as well.

Objectives:

1. Identify the many changes that occurred between the 2006 and 2009 IBC.
2. Identify the impact of the changes on the application of the 2009 IBC.

Presenter: Robert J. Schutz, P.E., P.S., CBO, has served as an Assistant Architect Administrator at the Ohio Board of Building Standards. While with the State of Ohio, he has oversight of the new Residential Code of Ohio program, including certification of local residential code departments and personnel. Previously, Bob served ICC as Manager of Instructors with responsibilities for the selection, oversight and quality of ICC's cadre of staff and contract instructors. His varied previous experiences include active military service, building code enforcement for several central Ohio jurisdictions, he also served as City Engineer and Director of Public Services; and Chief Engineer, for the Ohio Department of Health where he chaired the state's plumbing advisory board. Mr. Schutz has a civil engineering degree from Ohio Northern University with post graduate studies at the University of Southern California and the Ohio State University in environmental law, land-use planning and public administration. He is a registered Professional Engineer, Professional Surveyor, certified Chief Building Official. Bob instructs IBC structural and nonstructural seminars, all IRC subjects, mechanical, plumbing and fuel gas codes and administrative topics.
